Breakable Easter Egg

INGREDIENTS:

- Super White Candy Coating
- Jimmies
- Easter Bunny Sprinkle Mix
- Green Apple Gummy Bears

TOOLS FROM CKSA:

- Spatula
- Candy Mold #90-2608
- Angled Spatula
- Food-Safe Egg Carton
- Wood Hammer

- Melt Super White Coating in the microwave until completely melted-- 30 second intervals work best.
- 2. Once melted, add a generous amount of a jimmy sprinkle mix-- the color will not bleed out.
- Spoon the melted coating/jimmy mixture into each cavity of mold #90-2608. Use an angled spatula to drag the coating around the entire cavity.
- 4. Once each cavity has been coated, put into the refrigerator for 5-7 minutes.
- 5. Once the base coat has set up, add a thin sec ond layer of melted coating towards the top edge of each cavity.
- 6. Place the mold back into the refrigerator for 10 minutes.
- Once the egg shells are completely set, invert the mold to release each piece of candy coat ing.

- 8. Heat a plate in the microwave until it is hot. Use this to smooth the edges of 3 of your egg shells.
- 9. Fill the smoothed egg shells with a Eastery sprinkle mix & gummy bears.
- 10. Reheat your plate and smooth down one shell at a time. While the coating is still wet, set the shell on top of the filled shell to seal in the sprinkles & gummy bears.
- 11. Place completed breakable eggs into a food-safe egg carton.
- 12. Use a small wooden hammer to break open the egg!



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
